

# Southern Spain Trip – March 13-27, 2010

## FULL

Southern Spain: (March 13-27) Two full weeks experiencing Andalucia - the southeastern region of Spain. The best of all worlds: unpack once and settle into a jewel of a Mediterranean coastal resort town, Nerja, for two full weeks, yet take guided day trips to Malaga, Sevilla, Cordoba and Granada. A unique experience coupling Spanish language and culture classes the first week (3 hrs./day) with activities such as a cooking class, a tapas excursion, a wine seminar, a visit to Frigiliana (Moorish white-washed village nearby), etc. Several free days to plan your own itinerary (easy public bus system along the Mediterranean) or just kick back on the beach. Our particular program is based on their 50+ program, but I have customized it for our trip.

Included is transportation from Albany to destination, lodging, dinners on 4 all-day excursions (which, in Spain, is mid-afternoon for the main meal of the day), all coursework, afternoon activities, (optional activities may be available for an additional fee), guides and tips.

Continental breakfast may be added for \$39/wk. (Why pay for it if you're not a breakfast eater or choose to go for a 'full' breakfast?) \$2,309\* per person based on double occupancy (\$2,359\* non-RC10 fee paying members); \$195 single supplement; \* Plus \$137 US departure taxes - not locked until ticketed.

Rates include a buffer for potential increases in fuel and Euro exchange, but the sooner I can ticket the sooner I can remove that concern. No ticketing will be done higher than quoted. As soon as I fill 20 seats I will ticket, hopefully reducing this fantastic price further ... so, don't delay!

\$400 deposit ASAP to hold seat ... this will be ticketed on a first come, first served basis ... but no later than Oct. 10. (Again, as soon as I have a group of 20 minimum I will ticket, possibly saving airfare costs). \$700 due Nov. 6, balance due Dec. 4.
